The Hon. Member of the House of Keys (Mr Watterson) to ask the Minister for Infrastructure—

How much in total was received in each year in which public sector car parking was charged for; when charging was suspended; and when he plans to reintroduce it.

The Minister of Infrastructure (Minister Thomas):

The total received in each year for public sector car parking is as follows:

Year	Income
April 2016 to 31 st March 2017	£40,744.73
April 2017 to 31 st March 2018	£78,324.50
April 2018 to 31 st March 2019	£112,168.40

Car Parking charges were suspended in April 2020, as a result of the Pandemic lockdown, and the number of staff working from home.

There are currently no plans to reintroduce charging.
